Context: Written by David around 1000 BC

Central Truth: God lovingly forgives those who repent of their sins.

Focus: Observe a Biblical model of penitence and turn to God for the forgiveness of sins.

Golden Text: "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise" (Ps. 51:17)

Context: This Psalm of David was penned around 1000 BC

As from September 2019 we will embark on a strategy for discipleship growth here at College Street.

Our approach will be relational with three pertinent questions under the banner of 'Living what we Believe'. Each area of ministry/ Department will be guided to engage everyone: members and visitors in sharing, relating and learning opportunities to enhance our knowledge, understanding, and life choices to help us turn our commitment to Christian discipleship into a sustainable lifestyle.

During this period of time, we will search the Scripture for answers to questions such as:

What do we need to know (our beliefs)?

How do we need to be (our attitudes)?

What do we need to do (our behaviours)?

We expect to see evidence of transformation and growth in each individual expressed through changed lifestyles, testimonies, greater commitment to Christian service, perhaps the use of a personal development plan, enriched and enhanced ministry teams and ministries and most definitely an empowered and mature community of believers at College Street NTCG.

Why Being a Pentecostal Matters to Me



We value the vibrant worship and passionate preaching about our Lord Jesus and his kingdom along with the challenge of living to make God's kingdom a reality within our Pentecostal tradition. We can recall the pulling on our heartstrings in our youthful days to be part of the church on seeing the member's demonstration of holy joy in their lives.

The preaching of the Word in terms of re-telling and referencing the stories of the Bible has been powerful to us in relating to the challenges of life. The Word of God really comes alive with relevance for life in the 'telling' of our faith through stories traditionally called testimonies. This is when a church member tells his or her own story relating to how God intervenes on their behalf. Scripture tells us that we are overcomers by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony. Pentecostal worship can be spontaneous, enriching, and lively when being led by the influence of the Holy Spirit. Experiencing the move of God in worship as individuals proclaim the Lord's excellence and their love for God is powerful and captivating.

Another enriching aspect of our Pentecostal heritage is that we are part of a movement that is not limited to any location, group or culture. It is God's movement that has swept the world globally with its richness of the gospel in power and exploits. As Pentecostals we all share the same experience for it is the same Spirit who has filled us. We can recall great moments of being all alone with our Lord as well as shared times with other worshippers.

We have encountered many challenges in terms of our Pentecostal faith but when we consider how we have been nurtured and shaped within the Pentecostal church and the solid foundation on which we now stand we have no regrets. We are thankful for the opportunities that were given to us for our development in ministry and made us who we are today. God has indeed led us on our life-pathway using channels such as those who have spoken and invested into our lives and for which we are grateful. Their investment was not in vain. Today we serve in ministry that has taken us outside the boundaries of our denomination taking the gospel to those on the borderline of our society, bringing the message of hope to the hopeless, the message of reconciliation and redemption, setting at liberty those who are in captivity.

In a nutshell, to be Pentecostal is to be Christ-like in our witness empowered by the Holy Spirit. We are like a flower that is planted in the garden, if it is not watered regularly it will die. The Holy Spirit is the watering that we need to keep growing in the Lord. Our lives have been influenced by the power of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit-led life acknowledges the outpouring on the Day of Pentecost and the privileged access that every believer has to the power of the Holy Spirit today and for always. These are just some of the reasons why being a Pentecostal matters to us and why we proudly consider ourselves as Pentecostals.
