

MADE HUSBAND AND WIFE

- 1. Man Placed in Eden (Genesis 2:4-8)
- 2. Man Alone in Eden (Genesis 2:9-18)
- 3. Man and Woman in Eden (Genesis 2:19-25)

Central Truth:

Marriage, ordained in God , is between one mane and one woman

Focus:

Affirm that God created man and woman, and made them husband and wife, and to hold God-ordained marriage sacred.

Golden Text:

"From the beginning of the creation God made them male and female. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife" (Mark 10:6-7).

HUMAN SINFULNESS BEGINS

- 1. Sins of the First Humans (Genesis 3:1-13)
- 2. Hope in Spite of Failure (Genesis 3:14-4:2)
- 3. Acceptable Versus Unacceptable Worship (Genesis 4:3-16, 23-26)

Central Truth:

All have sinned and fallen short of glorifying God.

Focus:

Recognising that human sinfulness began with Adam and Eve, and receive forgiveness by trusting in Jesus Christ.

Golden Text:

"By one man sin entered into the world and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned" (Romans 5:12).

HUMAN SINFULNESS INCREASES

- 1. Human Became Exceedingly Evil (Genesis 6:1-7)
- 2. Noah Found God's Grace (Genesis 6:8-13)
- 3. Preparation for Coming Judgment (Genesis 2:14-22)

Central Truth:

God is merciful, but persistent sinning invites His judgment.

Focus:

Understand and accept that amid increasing sin and impending judgment, God is gracious.

Golden Text:

"God saw that wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually" (Genesis 6:5).


