This is our Testimony

Tiffany Dubidad



Growing up in Jamaica, I would always go to church with my grandmother. When we moved to the UK in 2010, my Mom and I attended College Street NTCG sometime after and this helped me deepen my relationship with God. I was baptised later in 2015.

I think the best thing for me right now about being a Christian is my relationship with God. Even being able to say I have a relationship with Him is such a privilege. This has been pivotal to my development and foundational to my worldview. The impact of this on me is, simply awesome.

For example, whilst a lot people think that change is the only guaranteed thing in the world, I am of the view that the only guaranteed thing is the promises of God through His word. What's more, is that God is equipping me with the necessary tools to interpret, practice and encourage others to have their own experience of who He is and have a personal relationship with Him.

One of the things I like most about our Church is the sermons. I've always found them to be very engaging. Pastor's preaching style has always been something I connected really well with. The translation to real life makes the Word relevant to my life, the incorporation of our Jamaican Patois reminds me of home and I love how excited and passionate the ministers get when they preach.

College Street is becoming more and more important in my discipleship growth and development. This is done through encouragement and the challenges I receive to do my best and the provision of different opportunities for me to experience Christian service and develop my understanding and commitment to Christian discipleship.

I think one of the biggest challenges for excited and devoted Christians in the wider world today is that there are too many lukewarm Christians that are in positions of influence who communicate confusing messages which undo a lot of the work that other dedicated Christians have done.

An example of this problem can be seen when some people in positions of leadership and are expected to be a positive influence on the younger generation and new Christians do the opposite because of spiritual immaturity, 'lack of fire', lack of conviction and an underdeveloped relationship with God.

Another challenge, I see is how rampant the sense of uncertainty and hopelessness is amongst young adults. Finding the right approach to encourage people in this category to develop a relationship with God and grow in Christian discipleship can be very difficult. However, drawing on my own experience, my encouragement to anyone who feels disheartened is to focus on the Word.

The answer to all the questions that present themselves can be found in the manual of life, the book of promises, the Bible. Make your relationship with God a priority. Once you have this, it will set the tone for addressing all the issues you are facing now and those to come.

Be always reminded of who you are in God's plan for you, your local Church and the wider world and don't let any issue deter you. Try to be an exemplary disciple of Christ.

I'd like to encourage everyone to get and stay excited about God. For those that are going through a trying time or those that have lost faith, their way or their hope etc, remember Jeremiah 29:11.

This alone will give you all the confidence you need to trust the process of Christian discipleship and Christian service and to know that God is in control.
