



This is my Testimony

Rev Virginia Thomas



I was born in St David's, Grenada; our family migrated to Chesterfield, Derbyshire in 1965. We attended a Methodist chapel nearby, but my dad began visiting

Pentecostal churches instead, finally settling at NTCG Chesterfield some years later.

I enjoyed going to Sunday school, it provided me with the foundation for learning about God through the Bible stories and also became involved in church life at a young age. However, once I began attending Secondary school, I stopped going to church – it would be 21 years later before I accepted Jesus Christ as my personal Saviour.

After leaving school, I attended college to pursue secretarial studies before working, and later secured an assistant post, prior to applying for training and posts toward becoming a qualified social worker in 1990.

After moving to Nottingham in May 1991, I sensed a deep emptiness in

life. During the course reconnecting with my dad, he invited me to Sheffield NTCG in August 1991. Convicted by the preaching. accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord and Saviour and began attending Nottingham NTCG. My conversion can only be described as transformational! In May 1992, I made a decision to be water-baptised and some months later I received the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Nottingham NTCG enabled me to grow spiritually. I joined a home prayer group with other new converts, learnt about the Christian faith and Pentecostal theology, the importance devotion of worship, and my relationship with God. 1 became actively engaged with attending Bible studies and Prayer meetings, Adult Sunday school, Family Training Hour evangelism and ministry. In 1992 I became involved in working within the Youth and Christian Education Department (YCED).

Looking back, I realise that my engagement in the life of the church enabled my discipleship growth and helped me to discover my spiritual giftings.

I was later put forward as the Youth and Christian Education Director in 1999. I completed my MA in Pentecostal & Charismatic Studies during 2004 – 2006; appointed as a youth pastor and put forward for exhorter's licence in 2008. A couple of years later I was asked to facilitate the 'Living the Faith' course at the LTC, where I am now a Board member.

By faith, I relocated to Northampton on 2nd November 2013 and have been serving as a Chaplain at St Andrews Healthcare since 6th January 2014.

In 2018 I was appointed as NTCG National Director of Chaplaincy – which is the Lord's doing - with the opportunity of developing chaplaincy at St Andrews and the concept and practice of chaplaincy within the NTCG vision and mission.

During my health challenges throughout 2021, I developed a deep intimacy with Abba Father and forever grateful for His amazing healing grace, love and faithfulness. I'm also thankful for the love of my own family during this time, which has drawn us closer together – as well as the prayers, support and love shown by my church family.

It's a privilege to serve as associate pastor at College Street and to encourage and mentor others follow their sense of calling and become involved in the life and ministry of the church. Ephesians 4:10 – 12 counsels us to ensure the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry and for the edifying of the body of Christ.

John 3:16 and Matthew 25: 35-36 are key texts for me - they keep me focussed on the importance of my service in the community beyond the church walls to which I am committed.
