

We are also hoping we can really create strong bonds and connections with our young people, so that we are not only supporting each other spiritually but as friends and brothers & sisters in Christ.



This is my Testimony

Sis Joy Hamilton



I became a committed Christian fifteen years ago, but my Christian journey started many years before then. My mum was not a Christian but she sent me to Sunday School. So from an early age, I knew something about

the Christian faith and the Christian discipleship.

The Lord was always calling me especially after I had a life and death experience whilst I was in Jamaica before I came to England. I was very sick and had an operation and 'died' on the operation table but the Lord restored me. I had an 'out of body' experience! I could see the doctors at work on my body and I found myself in hell and saw some awful things.

I pondered over this for many days without sharing it with anyone because I thought people might have thought I had gone mad. But one day when I went to see my doctor, I told her that I could remember when my heart stopped. I told her what I saw. I told her how many medics were working on me and what I saw them doing. The doctor was mystified by my story. She called another doctor

and asked me to tell them again and they said all that I told them was true. They were amazed.

I realised that God was with me but I was still not committed to Christianity. Fifteen years ago, I was convicted by the word of God when I heard the preacher calling people to make a decision about whether they wanted to go to hell or heaven. I said to myself, 'I don't want to go to hell again' and made a decision there and then to become a Christian and serve God.

In 2005, a friend introduced me to College Street NTCG. I enjoyed the worship and the 'togetherness' also the singing and worship and was drawn to the church. These are still aspects that I like most about our Church. I enjoy being involved in the prayer ministry of the Church also the privilege to clean the building. These elements of church life are important for me when I think what Church is about.

I believe that prayer is vital for every Christian. I know from experience how important this is in our relationship with God. God always answers prayers. Our prayers may not be answered in the way we expect and wish but in the end, we always realise that God's answers are always in our best interest.

Covid-19 has been a real challenge for me as it has been for everyone. I wasn't able to log in to any of the College Street Zoom/online services but I was able to sit with people who could and watched the live streams which I found very beneficial to my spiritual wellbeing. I would say, I coped very well during 'lockdown' because I had quality time with the Lord in prayer and I felt much closer than any other time. I would say that and love for the Lord mv faith increased as a result of the time I prayer during this time. I spent in learnt to lean on God and trust in him completely. I learnt to stand on his Word and not fear any sickness or trials that might have come my way.

One of my favourite Scriptures which ministered to me especially during lockdown is Judges 6:36-40. I like the way Gideon communicated with God and the faith and boldness he displayed. The story inspires me to communicate boldly in faith with God: my Lord and father, in the confidence that he is not partial and what he did for Gideon he will do for me and anyone else who choose to take his word seriously.

I would like to encourage the family of God to walk by faith and not by sight and to love one another the way Jesus did when he walked amongst people on earth. When we see others worse off than ourselves, we should see them through the eyes of Jesus and show them compassion and love the way Jesus did. We should always ask ourselves, What would Jesus do? I find that this works for me. It can be very challenging but it is very rewarding. With this in mind, we become 'givers' rather than 'takers' and we give ourselves the opportunity to receive the blessings as promised in Acts 20:35 (ESV) '....we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'

I thank God for Jesus and the Holy Spirit in my life and the privilege to be a part of the College St NTCG. I love to clean the church. I like to keep God's sanctuary clean and make it comfortable for everyone. The Lord gives all of us something to do and I do this gladly as a service to him. It is a blessing to serve the lord in this way. I would like to see more fresh flowers on display in our church again. They are pleasant to see and smell. I think they add beauty to the building and our worship. I am off sick at the but looking forward moment returning to this area of Christian service when I am better.
