



This is my Testimony

born I was and raised in the St Ann in Jamaica and brought up in a home that adhered the Christian faith. At about the age of 12/13, I was confirmed in the Church of England.

I did not become a

Pentecostal Christian until later on in life. In 2008, I was invited to the NTCG at College Street by a friend after which, I started to visit on a regular basis. On 11th April 2010, I was baptised and 11th July I received my full membership.

I like College St NTCG for the liveliness compared to the Church of England's laid-back way of worshiping. Engaging and inspiring, stirring and moving are words I would use to describe the worship experience at College St. I find the preached word and the Bible teaching vibrant, helpful and meaningful.

It is a privilege to be a Christian. One of the best things about being a Christian, particularly during this pandemic and hard times is that I've never felt alone because I've felt the love and presence of God. I draw strength and encouragement from Joshua 1:9 "Be strong and courageous; do not be frightened and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

Covid-19 has been challenging for all of us but as the saying goes, opportunities come with all challenges. One of the positive things about the Covid-19 pandemic is the way in which it compels us to be responsible citizens and think not only of ourselves but our responsibility towards others, for example, in the interest of our common good, be cautiously aware of our movements as guided, take the necessary precautions and stick to the protocols. The negatives are the confinement to our homes and the isolation that so many have had to endure.

The restrictions have had a great impact on the way we have had to do church. It has been very strange because we have never had to deal with a situation like this before. Zoom and online services were new and strange to most of us. Some other positive outcomes are that many of us have learnt new skills even new things about ourselves, the meaning of Christian discipleship and our relationship with our triune God. One thing I've learnt is that challenges do not stop me from giving God the praise nor stop me from worshipping him.

I am dreaming of a vacation somewhere nice and warm when the covid-19 restrictions are lifted; I think I deserve that!

For all times though, I pray that God will strengthen me on my spiritual journey, that I will grow in my Christian discipleship and find new ways to serve him and be the blessing he created and has blessed me to be. I am also praying that we will all look out for each other as brothers and sisters and encourage and support each other to grow in our Christian faith.


