Northampton Celebrates Windrush in 2021



On Tuesday 22nd June 2021, Northampton Town celebrated Windrush Day marking the anniversary of the arrival of MV Empire Windrush at the Port of Tilbury 73 years ago. This historic event took place outside Northampton Guildhall. Also the inauguration of the Northampton Windrush Generation and Descendants UK took place. Co-Founders Martin Cole and June-Elizabeth White-Smith-Gulley made the launch with the cutting of a ribbon, prior to the Mayor Councillor Rufia Ashraf, raising the National Standard Windrush Flag.

With the support of Northamptonshire Black History Association, Northampton Windrush Generation and Descendants UK organised and invited 30 guests to the celebrations. Among contributions were Bishop Donnovan Allen from New Testament Church of God and Pastor Green from Bible Way Church of Prophecy they addressed the numerous issues being faced by many people of the Windrush Generation but nevertheless offering hope through communication and prayer.

June-Elizabeth White-Smith-Gulley wrote and read a tribute poem that reflected her thoughts about the acknowledgement of the whole Windrush incident by the Government. Nicholas Mosses, a Year 13 student from Northampton School for Boys, spoke about his role in the creation of a play about the Windrush arrivals (started in Year 9) - interviewing his Grandfather and other relatives. He stressed how important it is for young people to learn about these histories. The High Sheriff of Northamptonshire, Amanda Lowther added her thanks for her invitation and then she was followed by Councillor Jonathan Nunn who spoke to the historical occasion which will become part of the Civic calendar adding to the many celebrations which already takes place in the town. The event gave both the Windrush Generation, their Descendants and the wider community a continued understanding of the valued contributions made by a group who have added to the rich diversity of this County and nation.

June-Elizabeth White-Smith-Gulley gave a vote of thanks to all who made this Windrush event for Northampton a real success.

This is my Testimony

born l was and raised in the St Ann in Jamaica and brought up in a home that adhered the Christian to faith. At about the age of 12/13, I was confirmed in the Church of England.

I did not become a

Pentecostal Christian until later on in life. In 2008, I was invited to the NTCG at College Street by a friend after which, I started to visit on a regular basis. On 11th April 2010, I was baptised and 11th July I received my full membership.

I like College St NTCG for the liveliness compared to the Church of England's laidback way of worshiping. Engaging and inspiring, stirring and moving are words I would use to describe the worship experience at College St. I find the preached word and the Bible teaching vibrant, helpful and meaningful.

It is a privilege to be a Christian. One of the best things about being a Christian, particularly during this pandemic and hard times is that I've never felt alone because I've felt the love and presence of God. I draw strength and encouragement from Joshua 1:9 "Be strong and courageous; do not be frightened and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

Covid-19 has been challenging for all of us but as the saying goes, opportunities come with all challenges. One of the positive things about the Covid-19 pandemic is the way in which it compels us to be responsible citizens and think not only of ourselves but our responsibility towards others, for example, in the interest of our common good, be cautiously aware of our movements as guided, take the necessary precautions and stick to the protocols. For all times though, I pray that God will strengthen me on my spiritual journey, that I will grow in my Christian discipleship and find new ways to serve him and be the blessing he created and has blessed me to be. I am also praying that we will all look out for each other as brothers and sisters and encourage and support each other to grow in our Christian faith.


