This is my Testimony

I was born and raised in Northampton in a non-Christian household and as a result I never went to church. My mum read the bible to me sometimes but I was never encouraged to read or to attend church. As a result I only went to church for events or special occasions.

In 2008, my husband Steve decided to visit a local Pentecostal Church. He came home and told me all about it and the following week I decided to also attend. I sat and listened as people sang, prayed and worshipped. The members made me feel welcome and I felt comfortable about going back the following week. However, although we were made to feel welcome, the strength of spirit that drew us there in the first place seemed to fade and after a few months we stopped going.

In 2020, Steve and I both agreed to give church another try. We originally intended to try a few different churches, beginning with NTCG. From our first visit to NTCG we were made very welcome by Bishop Allen and other members of the church and as a result we never got round to trying any other churches.

My life has changed so much in the last 18 months. I got baptised in May 2021 which was such a wonderful day and a very proud moment. We celebrated our 21st wedding anniversary in January of this year and had our relationship blessed by Bishop Allen.

I am now moving forward with my Christian journey and being involved with the hospitality team is helping me to get to know more people to help me on my way.

Gospel music has become a big part of my life and we now have a wide collection of gospel music which we sometimes have playing in the house from morning till night.

I give thanks to all my family and friends who have been with me on my journey and trust in God to give me health and strength so I can carry on.

I gain a lot of inspiration from Luke 1:37 (NKJV) *'For with God nothing will be impossible'*.

One commentary puts this in what I describe as very nice and simple words of wisdom which makes me feel comfortable and strengthened when I read it -

'Come to me with all your weaknesses: physical, emotional and spiritual. Rest in the comfort of my presence that nothing is impossible with me.'

This encourages me in my everyday life and I hope those of you who read my testimony will be equally encouraged by these words.
